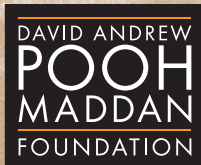

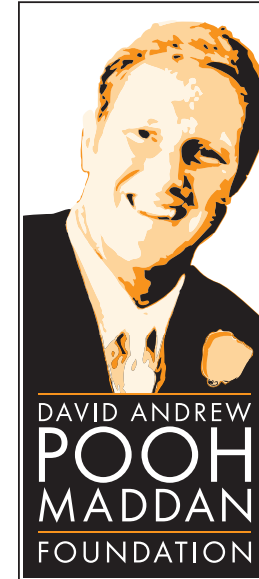

The David Andrew “Pooh” Maddan Foundation, a non-profit 501(c)(3) charitable organization, was established to honor and celebrate a life cut much too short as a result of complications related to the treatment of osteosarcoma (cancer of the bone). Among the many challenges that David faced during his battle with cancer, was leukemia resulting from chemotherapy.

David, or “Pooh” (his competitive swimming nickname), died unexpectedly at the age of 28 on October 25, 2008 after a blood vessel, weakened by all his treatments, burst in his chest. Pooh’s dream had been that a cure for cancer would be discovered and, in the meantime, that better therapies for this insidious disease would become commonplace. Dave also realized the immediate need for financial support for young adults diagnosed with cancer, an age group which is often overlooked.

David was passionate about establishing a non-profit foundation to assist other cancer patients as soon as he completed his own treatments. The proposed foundation was to have a two-fold purpose: to provide financial assistance to help young adult cancer patients, ages 18 to 35, receive the best therapy possible and to support research for targeted delivery cancer treatments, which would have fewer and less serious side effects than traditional chemotherapy. This Foundation is dedicated to realizing Pooh’s dream and to keeping his memory and legacy alive.

We are currently providing assistance to fifteen young adults to support them in their fight against cancer and are receiving more requests for aid every day.
